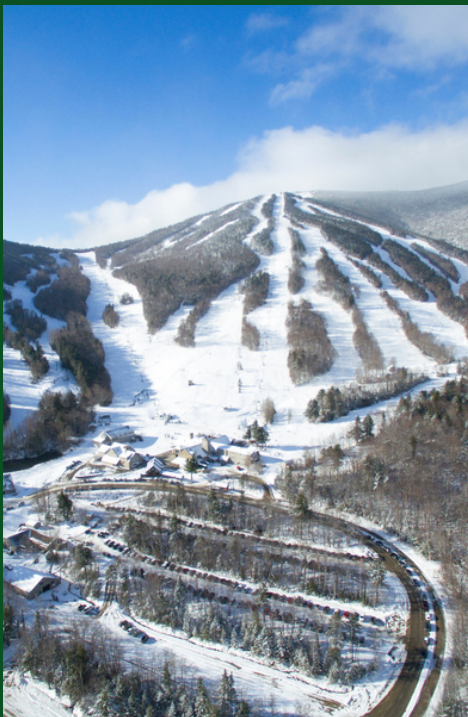

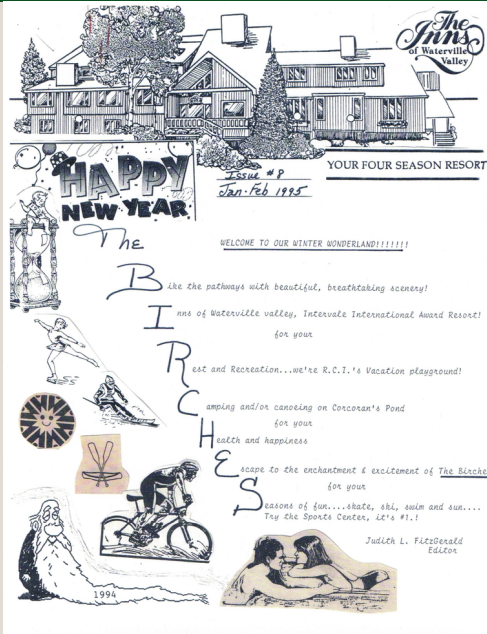


Dear IOWV Owners,

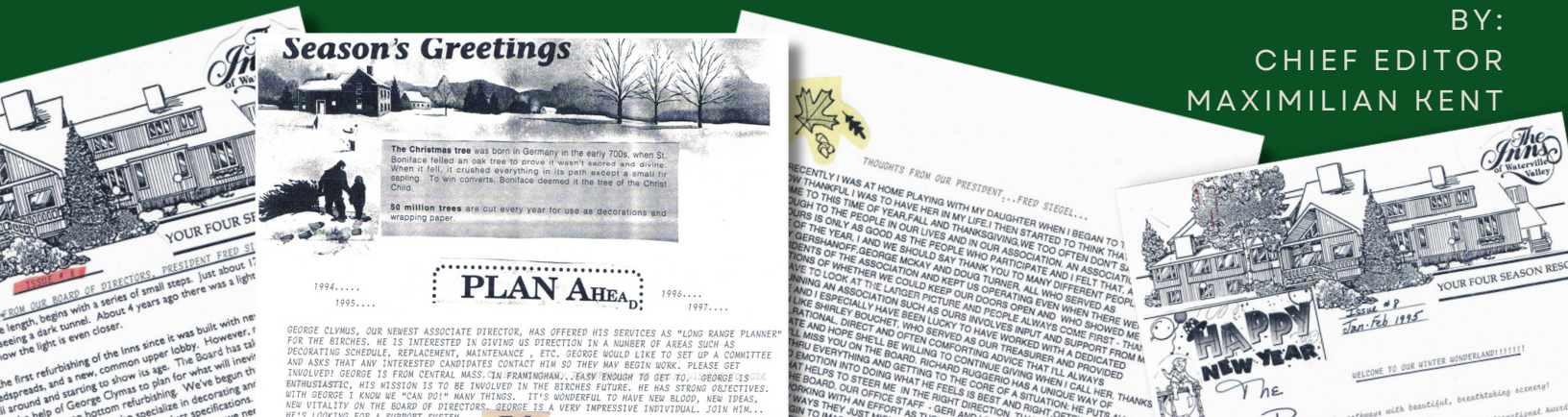
Thank you from Gail Kent.

2023 IS OVER, AND WE WELCOME ALL TO 2024!

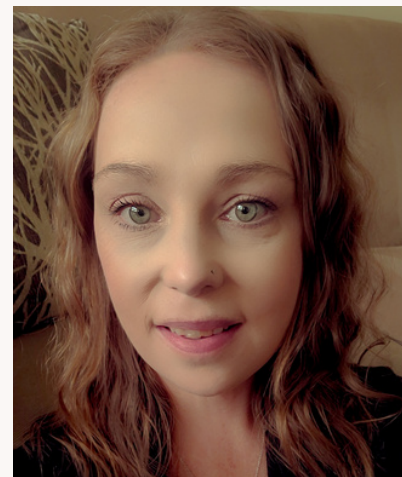
